**Four Fabulous Days of Free Music**

The Sound of Music festival is an environmentally responsible event and we need energetic people who are dedicated to the future ecology of our planet. Thank you for volunteering to help the festival accomplish the monumental feat of collecting and sorting 7 tonnes of refuse! Help us continue to reduce our ecological footprint! Below you will find the description of the area you are volunteering in:

**Area Picking and Maintenance** - You will be given a map and assigned specific areas that will need to be maintained. You will be responsible for keeping the grounds in your area clean of refuse, including the promenade. You will pull any garbage bags out of their cans when they are 75% to 100% full, tie them off and place the bags beside the cans so they are ready for collection. **CLOSED TOE SHOES MUST BE WORN.**

**Refuse Sorter** – This role is the absolute most important role of our Team. It is truly the most important role in impacting the Festival's ecological footprint. Your duties will include sorting the recyclables and compostables out of the refuse to ensure they don't end up in a landfill site. Let's work together to keep our planet beautiful for future generations! **CLOSED TOE SHOES MUST BE WORN.**

**Eco PR Services** - You will be located next to designated refuse dispensing areas. There will be 3 barrels clustered together; recycling, compost and litter. In an enthusiastic and friendly manner, it will be your responsibility to help our Festival visitors know which barrel their refuse belongs in. By this you will be helping our Festival visitors make a direct impact on reducing our ecological footprint. Throughout your shift you will also keep your area clean & tidy. **CLOSED TOE SHOES MUST BE WORN.**

**Shuttle and Express Service** - We have put a combined service (Burlington Transit and Express/Shuttle) into a simple but effective plan for the Festival. This will allow Burlington residents and visitors to park and ride on a bus. This will increase accessibility, capacity and reduce cars in the downtown area. The Festival's visitors riding the shuttle will be helping us to reduce our ecological footprint! Your duties will be to help ensure the smooth operation of our shuttle service at the Fairview Go Station south parking lot (start point) and/or the downtown depot.

**Bike corral** - This is a joint venture with the Fundraising Committee. This is a new initiative for the Sound of Music's quest to further reduce our ecological footprint! Your duties will be to assist Festival visitors and volunteers with the safe keeping of their bicycles. You will be responsible for collecting a fee for each bicycle to support the Festival for this service. For more details about this program, please see the "Fundraising" description.
