The Sound of Music Festival Logistics team are the ones responsible for the set-up, maintenance and tear down of the entire festival. Logistics takes care of everything...from fencing, tents, stages, electrical to toilets, if you see it in the park you know Logistics had their hand in it somewhere. Your contributions to this hard working team are greatly appreciated. **CLOSE-TOED SHOES ARE NECESSARY** for this job. Below you will find a brief description of the area that you have volunteered in:

Installing Posts and Signs – As in any large scale event there is a need for signage to let patrons know where it's all happening. Your task will be to help install the many signs that need to go up. There is some lifting involved and you should be able to work unsupervised in any weather. You will be working with small tools, so you should be familiar with them.

Set up – You will be helping with the set up of the park. This can and will include everything you see as stated above. You should be able to work unsupervised and be familiar with hand tools. You will be required to do some heavy lifting and having a G class license would be an asset. Please dress accordingly for the weather.

Set up – Family Zone – PLEASE WEAR CLOSED TOED SHOES, green patch if you have them. This activity only occurs on Saturday morning. You will be assisting the area manager in setting up the Family Zone. There are tents, tables, chairs, signage...etc that needs to be taken care of. You should be able to work unsupervised and be familiar with hand tools. There may be some heavy lifting involved and trips up a ladder. Please dress accordingly for the weather.

Set up and manning of parade barricades – This activity is done in conjunction with Parades. Your shift begins at 7am, you will meet up, load the trucks with the barricades for the parade, then drive along the parade route dropping the barricades off. At approx. 9:30am you will head back to City Hall for a brief meeting and you will be given a safety vest. After the meeting you will be dropped off at an intersection, where you will set up the barricades and stand at them during the parade to ensure that no vehicles enter the parade route. At the meeting you will be briefed on how to deal with different situations and what your tasks are to be. Please dress accordingly for the weather.

Tear down and manning of parade barricades – This activity is done in conjunction with Parades. At the start of your shift you will meet at City Hall where you will be given a safety vest and be briefed on how to deal with different situations while manning the barricades. After the meeting you will be dropped off at an intersection where you will set up the barricades and stand at them during the parade to ensure that no vehicles enter the parade route. After the parade a truck will come and pick you up and you will help collect the barricades from the parade. Please dress accordingly for the weather.

Tear down of the Park – You will be assisting with taking down and packing up everything. All SOM property is loaded into the cube vans and taken over to the Festival's storage unit. We save everything we can for use next year, so take care when pulling down signage, etc... Please dress accordingly for the weather.
